- Always have a second person to verify all cash handling

Food and drink

Adopt a jelly baby for the day

Chocolate, talking, watching television, using your favourite word.

Hair removal

Step class, boxercies, circuit training.

Craft fair

Charge for stall holders and run a raffle.

Fashion show

Team up with fashion store and include a glass of wine, auction and disco.

Fetes and fun days

Golf tournament or crazy golf

Try pub golf with specified drinks taken in pubs along the route. Each pub is a 'hole' and women's tees are allowed.

Jazz night and raffle

Kids' party

Clowns, face painting, jugglers, skittles, video corner, wet sponge throwing.

Kite festival

Pantomime

Adults or children

Raffles

Easter eggs, cakes, holiday, wine, meals, hampers, car hire.

Tombola

A bit of a variety from a raffle.

Stars in their eyes

Talent contest with Karaoke.

Wheel of fortune

Prize for the highest score.



Little and often

Bingo

In the local village hall or in the office on payday with a set of numbers announced each hour.

Blind date

Office or school and ask a local restaurant to donate a meal for two.

Bonus ball

In the National Lottery competition.

Car wash

Office car park or local street.

Caption competition

Christmas carol singing

Not to stop until you get paid.

Disco

Egg putting competition

Use an Ester egg and a golf putter.

Garage sale

Jokes and impression competition

Organise a fun day.

Karaoke night

Murder mystery evening

Mystery tour or car treasure hunt

Mile of coins

Invite people to place a coin on a design or do a small change collection.

Name the cuddly toy

Choose a name from a list and win the toy.

Quiz night and raffle

Wild West, around the world or black and white theme.

Picnic

Pitta and pies, sandwiches and sangria.

Slave auction

Swear box
